Unit Title Part #1: AGRICULTURE - TREES

Topic 1 What is a tree?

Learning outcomes:

- A tree is a living thing that grows, reproduces and dies.
- What they need to keep them alive.
- Learn what are some of Vanuatu's fruiting trees (**Read the Appendix**).

Topic 2 The parts of a tree

Learning outcomes:

- The different parts of a tree and their function: roots, trunk, bark, branches, leaves, flowers, fruit.

Topic 3 How does a tree live?

Learning outcomes:

- Trees need light and energy from the sun, carbon dioxide from the air, and water and minerals from the roots for it to live.
- Learn about the role of flowers growing on the tree, the parts of a flower, pollination, seed dispersal and germinations.

Topic 4 Where do trees grow?

Learning outcomes:

- Learn about some different tree environments in Vanuatu and how trees adapt to their different environments.

Topic 5 The community of a tree

Learning outcomes:

- Every tree has an immediate environment that's affecting its health. Learn what makes up a tree's immediate environment.

Topic 6 People and trees, and caring for trees

Learning outcomes:

- Learn to appreciate the importance of trees, about their many uses, about caring for the tree's immediate environment, and caring for the tree itself.
